**2A.** Consider a resolution canvassing the votes to declare the results of the general election held Saturday, May 14, 2011 for Councilmembers for Places One, Three and Five.

Mayor Pro Tem Gottel read the item into the record. He requested the City Secretary to read the results of the canvass.

The following was read into the record:

Randy Mays	208	225	433	40.06%
Doug Phillips	321	327	648	59.94%

It appearing that Doug Phillips received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Councilmember Place One. Doug Phillips is hereby declared to be elected to the office to serve a three-year term after qualifying.

That the following number of votes were cast for the following named candidates for the office of Councilmember Place Three, to-wit:

Ron Miller	207	208	415	38.85%
Patrick Jackson	198	179	377	34.84%

It appearing that no one received a majority of the votes cast for the office of Councilmember Place Three. Ron Miller submitted a withdrawal as a candidate for Place Three on Monday, May 16, 2011. Patrick Jackson with 34.84% and Carl Pankratz with 26.80% are hereby declared to be placed on the ballot for the run-off election to be held on June 18, 2011.

That the following number of votes were cast for the following named candidates for the office of Councilmember Place Five to-wit:

Chris Kilgore	342	348	690	63.24%
Chad McEntee	186	215	401	36.76%

It appearing that Chris Kilgore received a majority of all votes cast for the office of Councilmember Place Five. Chris Kilgore is hereby declared to be elected to the office to serve a three-year term after qualifying.

**A motion was made by Councilmember Phillips, seconded by Councilmember Davis, to approve this item as read. This item was adopted as RES-068-11. The motion carried by the following vote:**

A motion was made by Councilmember Phillips, seconded by Deputy Mayor Pro Tem Jackson, to approve this item as read. The motion carried by the following vote:


